Vinča is a suburban settlement in the outskirts of Belgrade. It is home to at least three sites of national importance – a **Neolithic archeological find from 5000 BC** and a museum dedicated thereto, the **Institute of Nuclear Sciences** of the University in Belgrade, and, finally, the enormous open-air, unmanaged **waste landfill** lying on the Danube's bank and receiving waste from all of Belgrade – the city that almost half of the country calls home.
