TRAIMING THE TRAIMERS - IN CYPRUS!

To ensure that the FARCE materials are widely used in adult education settings in our communities, it is important that we support teachers and educators in our communities to use our FARCE materials in their work with adult learners! For this, we needed to develop some training.


FARCE partners have developed a unique, 7-module training programme specifically for community and adult educators. These modules address the following topics:

- Module 1: Climate Change
- Module 2: Humour
- Module 3: Comedy and Satire
- Module 4: Stand Up Comedy
- Module 5: Comedy Performance
- Module 6: Creative-Satirical Writing
- Module 7: Comics

Through these modules, we provide educators with an overview of the comedic topic, and with educational materials and activities which they can apply to their teaching practice with adult learners.



To complete a first test of this course material with adult educators, CSI from Cyprus hosted a hybrid group of trainers from each of the other 6 partner countries – the UK, Finland, France, Serbia, Ireland and Germany – at a 3-day training event in Cyprus. This training allowed all partners to test these training materials in a live training session, and to gain feedback before we deliver this curriculum to trainers in each of our own communities.



This curriculum is currently being finalised in English, before being translated and uploaded to our online platform.
